6. By using scrap paper make a model of lungs and write a small introduction of lungs working.



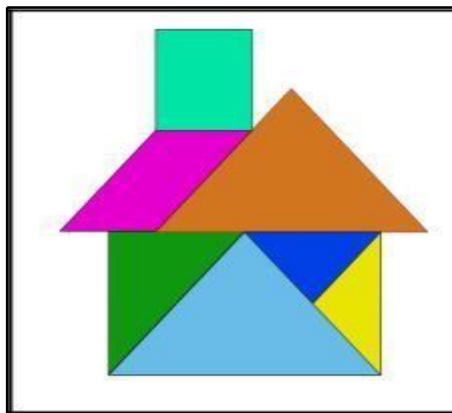
